**SECTION V – HEALTH HAZARD DATA- continued**

**EMERGENCY FIRST AID PROCEDURES:**

**EYE CONTACT:** flush immediately with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

**SKIN CONTACT:** wash with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing. Consult a physician if irritation persists. Do not re-use clothing until cleaned.

**INHALATION:** Remove to fresh air. Restore breathing. Get medical attention

**INGESTION:** Do not give liquids of victim is unconscious or drowsy/ Otherwise, give 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by giving 3 tbsp. Syrup of Ipecac.\*

**Note to Physician:** If victim is a child give 1 glass of water and 1 tbsp. Ipecac. If symptoms such as loss of gag reflex, convulsions or unconsciousness occur before emesis, gastric lavage should be considered following intubation with a cuffed endotracheal tube.
